

The following position, at the Freiburger Forschungs- und Lehrzentrum Musik (FZM) of the Hochschule für Musik Freiburg and the Albert-Ludwigs-University Freiburg, is to be filled for the summer semester 2022:

Tenure track professorship (W1 with tenure track to W3) for Music Physiology (100%)

We are looking for an individual who will further develop and represent the discipline of music physiology in teaching and research at the Hochschule für Musik Freiburg. The position is based at the Freiburger Institut für Musikermedizin.

The successful candidate has the task of covering the physiological and psychological foundations of music performance with regard to artistic, pedagogical and new emerging professions in music in the teaching of all three study cycles. The successful candidate shall continue to establish and further develop the independent study programme Music Physiology in research and teaching. In this context, digital teaching forms and formats should also be taken into consideration. Artistic music practice in academic teaching is desired.

In research, the successful candidate employs quantitative and qualitative methods of empirical research and their specific applications in different research designs. Continuous publication activity (including peer reviewed) is expected.

The willingness to participate in the academic self-administration of the Hochschule für Musik Freiburg as well as the inter-institutional cooperation of the Hochschule für Musik Freiburg with the Albert-Ludwigs-Universität Freiburg within the framework of the FZM is required.

Requirements for employment are a degree relevant to the discipline (music, medicine, etc.) as well as an above-average doctorate relevant to the discipline. Extensive experience in teaching music physiology, preferably at an institution of higher music education, is expected.

The tenure-track professorship is limited to six years. In the event of a positive interim evaluation and a positive evaluation for tenure track faculty promotion, the tenure track professor will be appointed to a full professorship (W3). The requirements for the evaluation procedure for tenure track faculty promotion, qualifications, and information about the formal process can be found in the respective "Qualitätssicherungskonzept" of the Hochschule für Musik Freiburg.

The Hochschule für Musik Freiburg aims to increase the proportion of women on its artistic and research faculty and encourages female candidates to apply. In the case of equal suitability, competences and professional qualifications, disabled individuals have priority in recruitment. We kindly ask you to submit your application with the usual documents (cv and description of your artistic/scientific career, evidence of teaching and teaching experience, copies of certificates etc.) digitally summarized in a PDF file. Publications (if available) each as individual PDF files, recordings in the form of audio files. **Please refrain from sending letters of recommendation.**
